

CRMC Press Release FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE.

Effective 3/30/2020, visitors will be prohibited at all CRMC locations including the hospital and clinic settings. No visitors or support person can accompany a patient with an appointment at CRMC – including all outpatient services, laboratory and medical imaging appointments. This decision comes after the announcement by Kansas Governor Laura Kelly that a “stay Home” order is now in effect until April 19, 2020.

Exceptions to this policy can be in certain scenarios. One healthy visitor that passes the entry screening may be allowed for:

- pediatric patients in the ED or inpatient units
- a geriatric or special needs patient that requires assistance
- hospice and palliative care patients
- the discharge of an inpatient
- patients in the Women's Health Unit for labor and delivery and/or post-partum care

CRMC is also closing its storm shelter to the public during this COVID-19 state of emergency. This is being done for public health concerns. Other storm shelters in Coffeyville include:
