A Resolution of the Board of County Commissioners of Montgomery County, Kansas, to Increase the Federal Mileage Reimbursement Rate

WHEREAS, on August 5th, 2024, the Board of County Commissioners of Montgomery County, Kansas, previously adopted Resolution No. 24-114, establishing a mileage reimbursement rate for county employees and officials; and

WHEREAS, the federal mileage reimbursement rate set by the Internal Revenue Service for 2025 has been adjusted to 70 cents per mile to reflect increased costs associated with fuel, vehicle maintenance, and insurance; and

WHEREAS, Montgomery County seeks to maintain a fair and consistent reimbursement policy in alignment with the IRS federal mileage rate to ensure that county employees and officials are properly compensated for the use of personal vehicles for official county business;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MONTGOMERY COUNTY, KANSAS, AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. Repeal of Resolution 24-114
 - Resolution No. 24-114, is hereby repealed and replaced with this resolution
- 2. Adoption of New Mileage Reimbursement Rate
 - Effective February 3rd, 2025, the mileage reimbursement rate for Montgomery County employees and officials shall be set at 70 cents per mile, in accordance with the IRS federal mileage reimbursement rate for 2025
- 3. Implementation
 - All mileage reimbursements shall continue to be submitted in compliance with Montgomery County's existing travel and expense reimbursement policies.
 - The Board of Montgomery County Commissioners shall review the federal mileage rate annually and make adjustments as necessary to maintain alignment with the IRS guidelines.
